



Spring Break Camp Boxes

Bits and Bots from Pint Size Science (K-2):

In this camp box, participants will explore the beginning steps in coding and programming. This box is made available in collaboration with the Iowa STEM council and the Science Center of Iowa.

Garden Science (2-5):

Learn what makes a plant grow, explore the science inside a plant, and use science to grow your own garden! Participants will discover the basic biology needed to grow a garden.

Exploring Engineering (2-6):

In this camp box, participants will become an engineer as they explore the engineering design process to complete three challenges to design and make a boat, a chair, and their own creation!

Switch it up! (3-5):

Consider what you do, view and chew over this break! Create a technology contraption, test a new recipe, and explore activities.

Homes & Habitats (K-5):

Participants will explore habitats of wildlife, observe wildlife in their backyard and record ideas in their scientist journal, and consider how they can support a healthy environment. They will also pick an animal and create a model environment to show where and how the animal might live.

A New Look at Gardens (3-6):

Participants will explore ways food is grown and practice some fun ways to use food too! Discover where a hamburger comes from, grow lettuce in water, and explore new ways to grow plants without soil!
