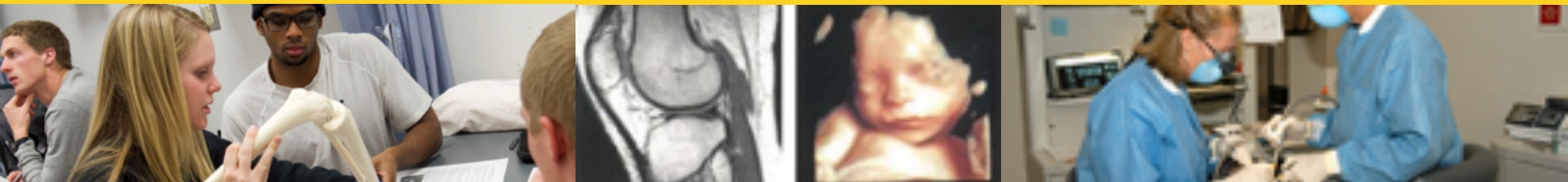

Physical Therapy

The Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) curriculum at The University of Iowa requires 2½ years post baccalaureate degree study and clinical experiences.

Radiation Sciences

Radiation sciences is one of two undergraduate majors in the field of medical imaging offered by the Carver College of Medicine. The other undergraduate major in medical imaging is nuclear medicine technology.

Dentistry

At the University of Iowa, dentistry is a professional degree program that requires applicants to complete at least three years of undergraduate college course work prior to admission.
