

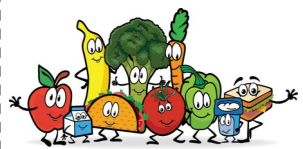

Most importantly... Thank you to all the students at East. Your hard work, smiles, and love of learning will take you far in life. Keep reading and learning!

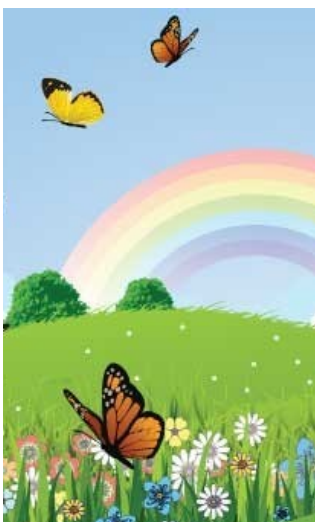
