The Wishing Tree Project to buy gifts for families in the Ballard Community begins on Wednesday, November 24, 4 – 6 PM. Community members with children, newborn – seniors in high school here at Ballard are able to fill out a wish list at the pantry. All information is confidential. Parents will need to fill out a list of wants and needs and put the list on the tree. Community members wishing to fulfill wishes are encouraged to come to the pantry as well and adopt a family from the tree. The project will end on December 8, the last day to request assistance and the last day to help a family.

Only one request per family and if your family is receiving help elsewhere, please do not duplicate requests.

The first 10 families to sign up will receive a decorated tree sponsored by Harvest Assembly of God Church, Huxley.

- PROJECT CONCLUDES Wednesday, DECEMBER 8TH . (LAST DAY TO FILL OUT A WISH LIST AND LAST DAY TO TAKE A WISH LIST)
- GIFTS NEED TO BE RETURNED TO PANTRY BY SUNDAY, DECEMBER 12TH.
- FAMILIES MAY PICK UP THEIR GIFTS Wednesday, DECEMBER 15 & Saturday, December 18.
- HOURS FOR THE PROJECT ARE: WEDNESDAYS 4-6, SATURDAYS 10-12 AND SUNDAYS 1-3
- PANTRY WILL BE CLOSED FOR THANKSGIVING ON NOV 27 & 28 AS WELL AS DECEMBER 15, & 18 TO DISTRIBUTE GIFTS AND DECEMBER 25 & 26 FOR CHRISTMAS.
