We are offering the ACT at Ballard High School on Saturday, April 15, 2023. This is a national testing date and will be the only testing date offered at Ballard High School for the 2022-2023 school year.

Please go to ACT.org to register for the ACT test. To register for the Ballard testing site, use the <u>Test</u> <u>Center Code 252110</u>. This Test Center Code will only be offered to 9th-12th grade Ballard students. The test fee of \$63 (ACT without the writing portion) or \$88 (ACT with the writing portion) is due at the time of registration. Test fee assistance for juniors and seniors from Ballard High School is available upon request. **The deadline for registering for the April 15 test is March 10**.
